The Paul Donnelly Scholarship is awarded each year to any applicant who fits the following criteria:

Applicants must be in their second semester of their senior year of high school.

Applications must be received at the above address by midnight, May 31st of the award year.

Applicants must be a child or grandchild of an active\* member of the Melvin Roads Post 1231 American Legion, the Melvin Roads Auxiliary, or the Melvin Roads Squadron [SONS] 1231. (\*Active means dues are paid up through the award year).

Applicants must either have been accepted at an accredited two or four year institution of higher learning, or have formally applied to such an institution. If an acceptance letter has not been received by the submission date of this application (May 31st), then such an acceptance letter must be in hand before an award is made.

The amount of the award is \$500. A check in this amount will be prepared on or before August 1st of the award year and will be payable in the name of the institution of higher learning and the name of the recipient.

The Paul Donnelly Scholarship Committee will review the applications submitted and determine the awardee. It is critical that information requested is complete and in the hands of the committee by May 31st.
